

Structure of the Kingston Regional PPC Association

People's Party of Canada (PPC) electoral district associations (EDAs) had been amalgamated across the country to enable sharing of resources. In Eastern Ontario, the Kingston Regional PPC Association was formed from three pre-existing PPC EDAs. These EDAs include: (i) Kingston and the Islands; (ii) Lanark - Frontenac - Kingston; and, (iii) Leeds - Grenville - Thousand Islands and Rideau Lakes.

The Kingston Regional PPC Association's Executive is made up of a Chief Executive Officer (CEO), a Chief Financial Officer (CFO), and a Secretary. The Executive manages the overall operation of the Association and coordinates the operations of the electoral districts (ridings). Each riding has a Riding Director that oversees the operations of the Kingston Regional PPC Association in the riding. Biographies and photos of the Association's Executive are given below.

In February 2021, the Kingston Regional PPC Association's Board of Directors and Executive had been acclaimed. Dave Senger took on the role of Eastern Ontario Regional Coordinator in late April 2021. The completed Kingston Regional PPC Association's registration form was sent to Election Canada in mid June 2021. Registration should be confirmed by the end of July 2021.

Teams have been established to handle operations for each of the Kingston Regional PPC Association's ridings. Currently each riding has a Riding Director and an operations team.

Government Mishandling of Covid-19 and Institution of Tyranny

In pretence of saving Canadian citizens from a COVID-19 pandemic, the federal government adopted the disease containment protocol from the Joint Commission of the World Health Organization (WHO) and China. The protocol includes unjustified restrictions of freedom used by the Communist Party of China to subjugate the people of China. These restrictions are in violation of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. However, the federal and provincial governments of Canada have proceeded with these unjust restrictions. Despite the unprecedented money creation, most small businesses have significantly suffered during the implementation of the WHO-China protocol. Organizations Working to Regain and Protect Freedom

Action has been taken to counteract the federal and provincial governments' violations of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. MPP Randy Hillier teamed up with the PPC founder and leader Maxime Bernier, MP Derek Sloan, and others to create the Liberty Coalition of Canada. This coalition is comprised of the End the Lockdowns National Caucus, a growing group of former and current elected representatives, along with the Professionals Against Lockdowns, which is a sub-coalition of frontline healthcare workers, legal experts & law enforcement officials.

No More Lockdowns Canada and the Liberty Coalition of Canada are two of the larger groups working to regain and protect Canadian freedoms. Internationally, a team of over 1,000 lawyers and over 10,000 medical experts, led by Dr. Reiner Fuellmich, have begun legal proceedings for crimes against humanity perpetrated by: the American Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the World Health Organization (WHO) and the world economics advisory Davos Group.

Association Plan to Help Regain and Protect Freedom

In federal politics, the PPC is the only hope for establishing good governance. Members of the PPC are aware that the presiding politicians do not abide by the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. It is the first time in the history of Canada, that authoritarian forces are using deception, fear tactics, coercion, discrimination, slander, harassment, and disruption to subjugate Canadians.

The Canadian government-controlled media is trying to subdue the influence of the PPC. However, the PPC's influence continues to grow in Canada. Personnel at PPC headquarters are currently working 12 to 13 hours per day. Their inboxes are overflowing with emails from Canadians that don't like what their federal and provincial governments are doing to them.

On Canada Day, 2021, the PPC was the only federal party in Ottawa at the Supreme Court of Canada supporting the pro-freedom anti-lockdown demonstration. After the demonstration, many PPC supporters, wearing their purple PPC shirts, continued to walk through downtown Ottawa promoting freedom and no more lockdowns.

It is anticipated that a federal election will be called in September. To prepare for this possible election, the Kingston Regional PPC Association will produce two PPC flyers. One flyer is to promote the PPC candidate and the other to promote the Party. The flyers will be delivered to every dwelling within the three ridings of the Association.

This effort by the Kingston Regional PPC Association to regain and protect freedom requires funding. At this time, a membership drive would be most beneficial in raising funds. Memberships are available via the Association's recently updated website. Funds from membership fees and donations obtained via the website are deposited directly into the Association's bank account. Membership details are sent to headquarters for the PPC HQ database and receipts are issued via email. Membership sales can also be made in person by cash or cheque via your Riding Director.

Freedom Fridays

To boost membership, the Kingston Regional PPC Association is having Freedom Friday events. These are held every Friday at 7 p.m. at a predetermined location posted on our social media and website. We hope you will join us and encourage others to come out and meet with us. As well, we have plans in the works to have Maxime Bernier to tour through our region. At these events, you will be able to meet your candidate and purchase PPC merchandise providing financial support for our democratic effort to establish good governance.

We have candidates for all three of ridings of our Association. This is encouraging and brings us closer to regaining our freedom and establishing good governance.
